make sure they cover all the good stuff...

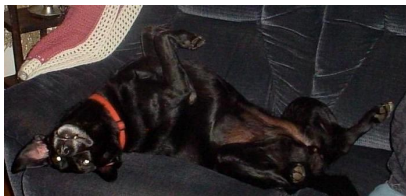
